Paper Entries Not On Official AKC Entry Forms and Photocopies of Entry Forms without Agreement and Rules of the Official AKC Entry Form are not acceptable.

CONFIRMATION OF ENTRY ACCEPTANCE AND JUDGING SCHEDULES WILL BE SENT BY EMAIL UNLESS OTHERWISE REQUESTED. Acknowledgement of entries will be made as soon as practicable after closing via mail or email. Should acknowledgement not be received by the exhibitor within a reasonable time, please notify the trial chair @piperaodonnell@gmail.com

POST-DATED OR RETURNED checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. ISAA charges a \$25 fee for any returned checks received. Added to this will be any bank fees that are charged. Funds will be accepted only in cash, certified check or money order for the entire balance.

ERRORS ON ENTRY BLANKS are the owner’s responsibility and no entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors or cancellation of entries after published closing date.

GENERAL REFUND requests must be received by the Trial Secretary prior to the closing date of March 23, 2023 at 11:59PM. Refunds will not be given for entries withdrawn after that date/time, with the exception of bitches in season. Please allow up to three weeks after the trial for refund processing.

CHANGES, CORRECTIONS OR ADDITIONS to entry forms must be received in writing prior to close of entries. Email any changes to the trial secretary at hrafna.isd@gmail.com

ENTRY FEES SHALL NOT BE REFUNDED IF a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by a Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee. No entry fees will be refunded if the Show cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, extreme and/or dangerous weather conditions, an Act of God, public emergency, act of public enemy, strikes or any other cause beyond the control of the Club or the organizing committee.

BITCHES IN SEASON shall not be eligible to participate in the obedience and rally trials. After the trials have closed, there will be a refund of entry fees for a bitch in season upon written request. Requests must be received by the Trial Secretary no later than the day of the trial (March 30, 2023). The request may be sent by U.S. mail or sent by email to hrafna.isd@gmail.com

AKC Obedience Regulations, Chapter 1, Section 14 states if so allowed by the host club, the trial secretary may enter and handle dogs in these trials. The Trial Secretary may enter these trials.

TRANSFERS are permitted as provided for in Chapter 1, Section 16a of the Obedience Regulations. The request for a transfer must be in writing and presented to the trial secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of each trial. Transfers may be approved provided the class and judge are available and the class has not reached its limit.

ANYONE IN NEED OF SPECIAL ACCOMMODATIONS OR SPECIAL ARRANGEMENTS should contact the Trial Chairperson by telephone or in writing in advance of the trial.

NO SMOKING allowed in any event buildings.

NO PRACTICING in rings at any time.

ZERO TOLERANCE: EXHIBITORS who do not clean up after their dogs will be excused from the trial. In such cases, no refunds will be made. All exhibitors must clean up after their dogs--outside, inside and in the ring. Violators will be subject to a disciplinary hearing.

THE TRIAL COMMITTEE will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, nor assume any liability in the event of an accident or misfortune to either dogs or exhibitors participating in this event.

JUDGES ARE NOT REQUIRED TO WAIT FOR DOGS. It is the responsibility of the owner/handler to have the dog at ringside when required and without being called.

ALL DOGS PRESENT must be held on a leash or confined to their crates except when being judged.

Any exhibitor whose dog or child engages in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the trial site.

EXHIBITORS SHOULD FOLLOW THEIR VETERINARIAN'S recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

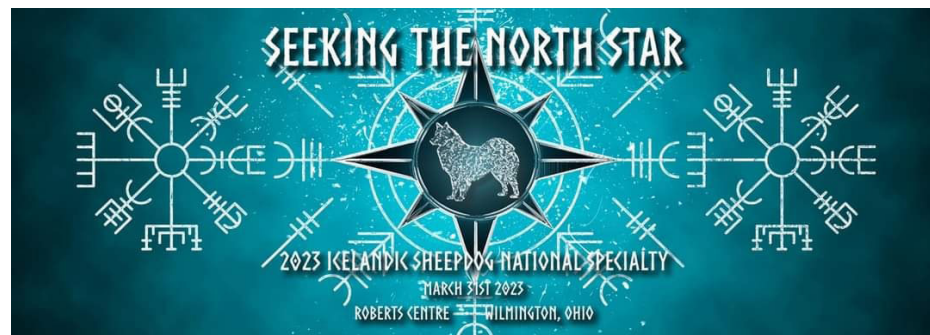
